Good Afternoon,

It appears that another winter storm is heading our way, and the timing of the anticipated snow accumulation could have an impact on our school operations. **Our elementary schedule for tomorrow will be adjusted to return to a half-day 12:30 pm dismissal** due to the winter storm advisory and anticipated ice and sleet in the forecast for the early afternoon. Please note the adjustments below for tomorrow, Thursday, February 18th.

- At this point, **no changes are planned for Rohrer Middle School or Haddon Township High School**. We anticipate following our normal half-day in-person cohort schedule.
- Our elementary schools will return to our Phase I implementation schedule and be dismissed at 12:30 pm.
- No lunches will be served, and no after-school care will be provided tomorrow. All students
  and classes originally scheduled to be in person from 12:30 pm to 3 pm will now be
  remote.

The timing of this storm can change, and we will be closely monitoring conditions this evening and tomorrow morning. If the predicted conditions decline at an earlier hour than currently anticipated, **please be prepared for a full remote day**. The decision to change to a full remote day will be announced no later than 6 am tomorrow.
