Good Afternoon and Happy Friday,

At last evening's Board of Education meeting, I provided an overview of our recent parent strategic planning survey results. The raw data is attached to this email, and some of the initial key insights are listed below. Thank you very much for taking the time to complete this survey, as we had over 1,100 responses!

## **Strategic Planning Survey Key Insights**

- 94% of current parents are either satisfied or very satisfied with the quality of our school district
- 90% of parents feel that our school district has **stayed the same or improved** since the time that they have lived here.
- 52% of parents believe that future strategic planning should only consider options encompassing neighborhood (geographic) elementary schools.
- 70% of parents feel that a Preschool/Kindergarten building paired with four neighborhood schools is *an acceptable* or *very acceptable* long-term plan.

Also attached is a ppt deck that was presented last evening for your review. As we prepare for our Phase III implementation **on Monday, April 12th**, I would like to remind you that we have travel restrictions for states other than New Jersey, Pennslyvania, New York, Delaware, and Connecticut. If you plan to travel outside of these states over spring break, individuals should follow a 10-day quarantine. A reduced quarantine time of 7 days can be implemented with a negative test result 3-5 days after returning home.

Please know that we are doing everything possible to maximize time in school for students in the final stretch of this incredibly challenging journey. Likewise, for students who choose to stay remote, we are equally committed to providing high-quality instruction. I continue to proud to be your superintendent as we fight COVID-19 and would like to acknowledge the courage and dedication of our staff, our students' resilience, and the patience of our parents. As Hawks, we will rise above.
