Shared Vision Community Forum

Next Wednesday, April 13th, at 7:30 PM, the Board of Education will host a special **virtual** community meeting with the public. Ms. Anne Gemmel from FutureWorks Alliance will be our moderator. The purpose is to inform the public of the feedback from the recent strategic planning survey that the community completed. Our shared vision process began more than two years ago by revamping the district's mission statement, inviting stakeholders to complete various survey monkey forms, engaging focus groups with community interviews, and the SchellingPoint data survey. Since starting the role of Superintendent of Haddon Township Schools, it was quickly apparent how much interest and passion parents and community members alike have for our school district. The Board of Education and district staff have done everything that we can to maximize opportunities for community collaboration, and we clearly understand and embrace the value of an engaged school community.
