Dear Haddon Township School District Community,

Last evening, the Board of Education took formal action to approve next year's school budget with a 2% increase to the local tax levy, which will result in a **\$41.36** increase to the average assessed home. Unfortunately, as you are aware, a significant financial deficit still persists, and we are continuing to advocate for our state funding that was unexpectedly reduced. The presentation utilized last evening is attached to this email, along with the video link to the meeting. Also, during the public comment section, there was a question about increases in the district's special education classification rates over the last year school, which have increased by 30 additional students. This correlates to a **two percent** increase from last year when the district's classification rate was **18.8%** of total students until now, where it is **20.7%**. Thank you very much for your continued support, and have a great weekend.
