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Dear Parents and Guardians:

Haddon Township School District is following the COVID-19 guidelines from the NJDOH. We ask for your continued cooperation in completing the Daily Health Screening tool accurately and before your child arriving at school.

Please keep your child home if any household members have COVID-19 symptoms or are getting a COVID test. Any of the symptoms listed below could indicate a COVID-19 infection in children and may put your child at risk for spreading illness to others. Please note: this list does not include all possible symptoms, and children with COVID-19 may experience any, all, or none of these symptoms.

Column A

Chills	Fever over 100 (as per HTSD policy)
Shivers	New loss of taste or smell
Muscle aches	Cough
Headache	Shortness of breath
Sore Throat	Difficulty breathing
Nausea or vomiting	
Diarrhea	
Fatigue	
Congestion or runny nose	

Students who are sick with fever, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea should not attend school in person. If TWO OR MORE of the Column A fields are checked off, or if ANY field in column B is marked, please keep your child home for ten days. If your child returns to school sooner than the recommended ten day period, they will require a doctor's note clearing them to do so.

Close Contact/Potential Exposure FAQs

In the past 14 days:

Has your child been in close contact (within 6 feet of an infection person for 15 minutes or more during a 24 hour period) with a person with COVID-19?
Has someone in your house been diagnosed or is being tested for COVID-19?
Has your child has traveled from any US state or territory outside of New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Delaware and is not otherwise exempt form quarantine under the NJ DOH travel restrictions?

If you answer “Yes” to any of the above questions, contact your school nurse for isolation and quarantine recommendations.
